Reminder

Modules with a quota (listed above) are only available to Entrant (i.e. new first year) students in the appropriate Faculty (students here on a study abroad exchange, JYA or JS1A, should be treated as Entrant students). All others may not take these modules: this includes second years and Honours students, and Entrant students in other Faculties. If you find that any of your students have advised themselves into modules with a quota and they are ineligible (2nd year and Honours), please remove them and ask them to choose something else.

6. AMENDMENTS TO PROGRAMMES

There are clarifications within the History Programme Requirements for Arabic Honours degrees, Modern History (Single and Joint) and Scottish History (Single and Joint) - see September pdfs for full entries but the following highlight the essential information:

Arabic Joint Honours programmes:

MO2007 is no longer a prerequisite for Honours entry - students are required to achieve 11 or better in AR2001 and AR2002 at Level 2.

Modern History

In order to enter *Single Honours Modern History* or *Joint Honours programmes involving Modern History*, you must

- gain passes in MO1005 and MO2006;
- gain 40 further credits from any two of the following: MO1006, MO2007, SC2004;
- *achieve grades of 11.0 or better* in two 2000 level modules;

- have gained the passes of 11.0 or better in the first round of assessment as results at reassessment will not give an entitlement to enter Honours.*

Scottish History (as of 2008-9)

In order to enter *Single Honours Scottish History or Joint Honours programmes involving Scottish History* you must:

- pass a Minimum of at least two modules out of MO1005, MO1006, ME1001 and ME1004;
- gain passes of 11 or more in both SC2003 and SC2004.
