

## School of Management

### Automatic Entry to Honours

Students who attain an average of grade 11.0 or above at the first sitting in the requisite 2000-level modules and who meet all other programme requirements will be given automatic offers of entry into Honours programmes.

Students permitted automatic entry to Honours will only be permitted to trail one module to a maximum of 30 sub-honours credits into Honours.

### BSc / MA Honours

The general requirements are 480 credits over a period of normally four years (and not more than five years) or part-time equivalent, of which the final two years form an approved Honours programme of 240 credits, of which 90 credits are at 4000 level and at least a further 120 credits at 3000 and/or 4000 levels.

### BSc / MA Honours with Integrated Year Abroad

The general requirements are 540 credits over a period of normally five years (and not more than six years) or part-time equivalent, of which the final three years are an approved Honours programme of 300 credits, of which 60 credits are gained during the integrated year abroad, 90 credits are at 4000 level and at least a further 120 credits at 3000 and/or 4000 levels.

**Study Abroad:** In the case of students who spend part of the Honours programme on a recognised Study Abroad scheme, the Programme Requirements will be amended to take into account overseas courses which are approved by the relevant St Andrews School in the Learning Agreement.

### Management - Single Honours BSc or MA

First Year:	40 credits: MN1001 <b>and</b> MN1002
Second Year:	40 credits: MN2001 <b>and</b> MN2002 - with mean grade 11 or better.
Third Year:	60 credits: MN3102 <b>and</b> MN3201 <b>and</b> MN3202; 60 further credits: MN3101 - MN4299.
Fourth Year:	20 credits: MN4311; 100 further credits in five of MN3101 - MN4989.

In Third and Fourth Years, 20 credits may be substituted by credits from another School or ID modules, with the permission of the Honours Adviser and the relevant Head of School.

In total, 240 credits must be achieved at 3000 and 4000 level with at least 90 of these at 4000 level.

Fourth Year: 20 credits: MN4311; Up to 40 further credits: MN3101 - MN3199, MN3203- MN4299, MN4310, if necessary, to a total of between 60 and 100 credits in Management across Third and Fourth Years.  In total, 240 credits must be achieved at 3000 and 4000 level, including at least 90 credits at 4000 level.

### Management Science - Single Honours BSc

First Year:	60 credits: MN1001 <b>and</b> MN1002 <b>and</b> MT1002. <i>(Students without prerequisite for MT1002 will take MT1001 in Semester 1.)</i>
Second Year:	40 credits: MN2001 <b>and</b> MN2002 - with mean grade 11 or better; AND 60 credits: MT2001 (unless taken in First Year) <b>and</b> MT2004. OR - from 2014/5 45 credits: MT2501, MT2504, MT2508.
Third Year:	80 credits: MN3101 <b>and</b> MN3102 <b>and</b> MN3201 <b>and</b> MN3202; 15 credits: MT3832 <b>or</b> MT3833; Between 15 and 30 credits: MT3706, MT4527, MT4608 - according to availability on a 2-year cycle.
Fourth Year:	20 credits: MN4203; Further credits: MT3706 <b>or</b> MT4527 <b>or</b> MT4608 if necessary, to a total of 30 credits from these modules; 15 further credits: MT3832 <b>or</b> MT3833; 80 further credits: MN3101 - MN4989.
In total, 240 credits must be achieved at 3000 and 4000 level, including at least 90 credits at 4000 level.	

### Management Science - Joint Honours BSc

<b>Management Science and one of:</b> Computer Science, Economics, Mathematics, Statistics	
First Year:	60 credits: MN1001 <b>and</b> MN1002 <b>and</b> MT1002. <i>(Students without prerequisite for MT1002 will take MT1001 in Semester 1, otherwise MT2001 recommended in this Year.)</i>
Second Year:	40 credits: MN2001 <b>and</b> MN2002 - with mean grade 11 or better; AND 30 credits: MT2001 (unless taken in First Year, in which case MT2004 recommended) OR - from 2014/5 30 credits: MT2501 and MT2504.
Third Year:	40 credits: MN3101 <b>and</b> MN3102 15 credits: MT3832 <b>or</b> MT3833;
Fourth Year:	20 credits: MN4311; 15 further credits: MT3832 <b>or</b> MT3833; Between 20 and 40 further credits: MN4101 - MN4299, MN4310.
In total, 240 credits must be achieved at 3000 and 4000 level, including at least 90 credits at 4000 level.
