

Modern Languages (Arabic - Persian) and Middle East Studies – Joint Honours MA

First Year and

Second Year: 20 credits: ME1003 or MO1008

20 credits: MH2002 - with a pass at grade 11 or better.

40 further credits from: ME1003, ME2003, MO1008 or HI2001 - with a pass at grade 11 or better in either HI2001 or ME2003.

Third Year: 30 - 60 credits: IR3300 - IR3320*, ME3160 - ME3189, ME3601 - ME3689, MO3080 - MO3095, MO3180 - MO3195, MO3280 - MO3295, MO3380 - MO3395, MO3480 - MO3495, MO3580 - MO3595, MO3780 - MO3795.

Fourth Year: 30 credits: HI4997 or HI4999 or ML4794.

*IR modules outwith this range may also be allowed, with the permission of the Director of Teaching of Middle East Studies.

In total, 240 credits must be achieved at 3000 and 4000 level, including at least 90 credits at 4000 level.

Admittance to 3000- and 4000-level IR modules requires permission from the Honours Advisers in Middle East Studies and International Relations. Students will normally be expected to have met the requirements for Honours entry to the School of International Relations.

Persian

Persian – Joint Honours MA

Persian and one of: Arabic, Comparative Literature, Economics, French ^W, German ^W, International Relations, Italian ^W, Management, Mediaeval History, Middle East Studies, Modern History, Russian ^W, Spanish ^W.

^W Available also as 'With Integrated Year Abroad' degree although at present only with a placement through the other language subject.

First Year: 40 credits: PR1001 and PR1002.

Second Year: 40 credits: PR2001 and PR2002 - with a pass at grade 11 or better in PR2002.

Third Year: 30 credits: PR3001 and PR3002;
Up to 45 further credits from PR3000 - PR4095, ML3201.

Fourth Year: 30 credits: PR4001 and PR4002;
Up to 45 further credits: PR3000 - PR4095, PR4098 or PR4099, ML3201, ML4794 across Third and Fourth Years

Students must take up to a total of between 90 and 150 credits in Persian across Third and Fourth Year.

In total, 240 credits (300 for WIYA programmes) must be achieved at 3000 and 4000 level, including at least 90 credits at 4000 level.

Persian (Modern Languages Triple Subject) - Honours MA

Persian and two of: Arabic, French, German, Italian, Russian, Spanish

All of the above are available also as 'With Integrated Year Abroad' degrees although at present not with a placement through Arabic or Persian.

**Persian element of MATriple Subject Honours
(where the other two subjects are both from the School of Modern Languages):**

First Year: 40 credits: PR1001 and PR1002.

Second Year: 20 credits: PR2001 and PR2002 with a pass at grade 11 or better in PR2002.

Third Year: 30 credits: PR3001 and PR3002;

Fourth Year: 30 credits: PR4001 and PR4002;
Up to 30 Further credits: PR3000 - PR4095, PR4098 or PR4099, ML3201, ML4794.across Third and Fourth Years

In total, 240 credits (300 for WIYA programmes) must be achieved at 3000 and 4000 level, including at least 90 credits at 4000 level.

One year or one semester may be spent in Study Abroad on a recognised Exchange scheme in the other Language subject.

Modern Languages - Programme Requirements 2015/6 - August 2015

Persian and one of: Arabic, French, German, Italian, Russian, Spanish

and one of: Ancient History, Classical Studies, English, International Relations, Latin, Management

All of the above are available also as 'With Integrated Year Abroad' degrees although at present not with a placement through Arabic or Persian.

Persian and Arabic and Middle East Studies

Persian element of MA Triple Subject Honours

(where one of the other two subjects is not from the School of Modern Languages:

First Year: 40 credits: PR1001 and PR1002.

Second Year: 40 credits: PR2001 **and** PR2002 - with a pass at grade 11 or better in PR2002.

Third Year: 30 credits: PR3001 and PR3002;

Fourth Year: 30 credits: PR4001 and PR4002;

Up to 30 Further credits: PR3000 - PR4095, PR4098 or PR4099, ML3201, ML4794 across Third and Fourth Years

In total, 240 credits (300 for WIYA programmes) must be achieved at 3000 and 4000 level, including at least 90 credits at 4000 level and between 150 and 180 credits in Third and Fourth Years from the two subjects in the School of Modern Languages.

Subject to the approval of the other School involved, one year or one semester may be spent in Study Abroad on a recognised Exchange scheme.

Persian minor element of MA Honours

First Year: 40 credits: PR1001 and PR1002.

Second Year: 20 credits: PR2001 and PR2002- with a pass at grade 11 or better in PR2002.

Third Year: 30 credits: PR3001 and PR3002;

Fourth Year: 30 credits: PR4001 and PR4002;

Up to 30 Further credits: PR3000 - PR4095, PR4098 or PR4099, ML3201, ML4794 across Third and Fourth Years

In total, 240 credits must be achieved at 3000 and 4000 level, including at least 90 credits at 4000 level.
