First Year:	40 credits: (GM1001 <b>with</b> GM1002) <b>or</b> (GM1003 <b>with</b> GM1004).
Second Year:	At least 40 credits: (GM2001 <b>with</b> GM2004) <b>or</b> (GM2002 <b>with</b> GM2003) <b>or</b> (GM2007 <b>with</b> GM2010) <b>or</b> (GM2008 <b>with</b> GM2009) - with an average of grade 11 or better over in all GM modules taken.

Third Year: 30 credits: GM3005 **and** GM3006;  
 Up to 30 credits: GM3010 - GM3099, GM4000 - GM4095.

Fourth Year: 30 credits: GM4105 **and** GM4106;  
 Up to 30 further credits: GM3010 - GM3099, GM3103, GM4000 - GM4095, ML4794.

In total, 240 credits (300 for WIYA programmes) must be achieved at 3000 and 4000 level, including at least 90 credits at 4000 level.
