

## Social Anthropology

### Social Anthropology - Single Honours MA

First Year:	20 credits: SA1002 (20 further credits from SA1001 recommended).
Second Year:	40 credits: SA2001 <b>and</b> SA2002 - with passes at grade 11 or better in both.
Third Year:	90 credits: SA3000 - SA3999; 30 further credits: SA3000 - SA4089, SA4400 - SA4899, except that with the permission of the Director of Teaching and the relevant Head of School, these credits may be taken from another subject. <i>(SA3506 must be taken if the student wishes to take SA4099 in Fourth Year.)</i>
Fourth Year:	30 credits: SA4098 <b>or</b> SA4099 <b>or</b> (SA4301 <b>with</b> ID4002); 60 credits: SA4000 - SA4089, SA4400 - SA4899 (except SA4794 - SA4797); 30 further credits: SA3000 - SA4899.

### Social Anthropology - Joint Honours MA

**Social Anthropology and one of:** Ancient History, Arabic, Art History, Classical Studies, Classics, Comparative Literature, Economics, English, Film Studies, French<sup>W</sup>, Geography, German<sup>W</sup>, Greek, International Relations, Italian<sup>W</sup>, Latin, Mediaeval History, Middle East Studies, Modern History<sup>H</sup>, Persian, Philosophy, Psychology, Russian<sup>W</sup>, Scottish History<sup>H</sup>, Spanish<sup>W,T</sup>, Theological Studies.

#### Social Anthropology element of MA Joint Honours

First Year:	20 credits: SA1002 (20 further credits from SA1001 recommended).
Second Year:	40 credits: SA2001 <b>and</b> SA2002 - with passes at grade 11 or better in both.
Third Year:	30 credits: SA3000 - SA3999; 30 further credits: SA3000 - SA4089, SA4400 - SA4899. <i>(SA3506 must be taken if the student wishes to take SA4099 or SA4794 or SA4796 in Fourth Year.)</i>
Fourth Year:	60 credits: SA4000 - SA4299, SA4400 - SA4899, (SA4301 <b>with</b> ID4002).
In total, 240 credits must be achieved at 3000 and 4000 level, including at least 90 credits at 4000 level.	

**Social Anthropology and Ancient History & Archaeology - Joint Honours MA**

First Year: 40 credits: AN1001 **and** AN1002.  
40 credits: SA1001 and SA1002.

Second Year: 40 credits in two of: AN2002, AN2003, CL2003, CL2004 - with passes at grade 11 or better in both.  
40 credits: SA2001 and SA2002 - with passes at grade 11 or better in both.

Third and Fourth Years:

30 credits: AA3020 - in Third Year only;  
*(SA3506 must be taken if the student wishes to take SA4099 in Fourth Year.)*

60 credits: AA4000 - AA4989, CL4600 - CL4699;

90 credits: SA3000-SA4090 (SA3506 must be taken in third year if the student wishes to take SA4099 in Fourth Year)

30 - 60 credits in one of {CL4999 or CL4794}, ID4794, ID4795, SA4098, SA4099, SA4794, SA4796 (ID4002 and CL4990 or SA4301) – in Fourth Year only

Further credits from AA4000 - AA4989, SA4000 - SA4090 to a total of 240 across both Honours years.

**Social Anthropology 'with'... - Honours MA**

**Social Anthropology with Geography**

**Social Anthropology Major element of MA Honours 'with' degree:**

First Year: 20 credits: SA1002 (20 further credits from SA1001 recommended).

Second Year: 40 credits: SA2001 **and** SA2002 - with passes at grade 11 or better in both.

Third Year: 60 credits: SA3000 - SA3999;  
30 further credits: SA3000 - SA4089, SA4400 - SA4899.  
*(SA3506 must be taken if the student wishes to take SA4099 in Fourth Year.)*

Fourth Year: 30 credits: SA4098 **or** SA4099 **or** SA4794 **or** SA4796 (SA4301 **with** ID4002);  
30 credits: SA4000 - SA4089, SA4400 - SA4899;  
30 further credits: SA3000 - SA3999, SA4000 - SA4089, SA4400 - SA4899.

In total, 240 credits must be achieved at 3000 and 4000 level, including at least 90 credits at 4000 level.

**... 'with' Social Anthropology - Honours MA**

**Economics with Social Anthropology, Geography with Social Anthropology**

**Social Anthropology Minor element of MA Honours 'with' degree:**

First Year: 20 credits: SA1002 (20 further credits from SA1001 recommended).

Second Year: 40 credits: SA2001 **and** SA2002 - with passes at grade 11 or better in both.

Third Year: 30 credits: SA3000 - SA3499;

Fourth Year: 30 credits: SA4000 - SA4089, SA4400 - SA4899 (except SA4794 - SA4797).

In total, 240 credits must be achieved at 3000 and 4000 level, including at least 90 credits at 4000 level.

Students still completing degree programmes as defined in previous Course Catalogues should discuss their module selections with their Honours Adviser(s).
